- V_{reserve}(V_D) is the groundwater Reserve as reported by RDM
- V_{allocated(WARMS)}(V_B) is the amount of groundwater that has been made available for abstraction(allocated) as recorded with WARMS

At Quaternary scale (Reserve scale) the availability can be re-written to show the terms by their data sources as:

For further clarity, the terms have been assigned letters during the champion discussions:

OR

$$V_{\text{available}} = V_{\text{C}} - V_{\text{D}} - V_{\text{B}}$$

The class shall then be determined according to the following rule

- Negative %_{allocated}: over allocated
- 0 94 %_{allocated}: under allocated
- 95 105 %_{allocated}: fully allocated
- Greater than 105 %_{allocated}: over allocated
